Our Vision:

Our Guidelines:

- Parents are asked to be prompt in both dropping off and picking up their children. The Youth Ministry Staff is required to remain until the last participant is picked up. Youth may not be unattended in the meeting area at any time.
- Unless other arrangements are approved in advance, the youth shall not be allowed to leave an activity before its scheduled end or leave at the end of the event with anyone other than a parent or the person that brought the youth to the event.
- Youth will respect the authority of each adult involved in the Youth Ministry. In the event that this respect is not given, parents will be immediately informed.
- Please be polite and courteous in action and word. Control your tongue. No foul language, cursing, cussing, swearing, or use of our Lord's name in vain.
- The rights and privacy of others are to be respected at all times. On overnight events there will be separate sleeping areas for men and women, and announced curfew times will be respected.

- Please keep your hands to yourself, this includes: no fighting, no roughhousing and no public displays of affection.
- We are caretakers of all God has given us. This includes property of other persons and places-wherever we may be. Participants are held financially responsible for any damage to property.
- The use of or possession of tobacco products, alcohol, controlled substances, firearms, knives, fireworks, or weapons of mass destruction are strictly prohibited.
- In light of the spiritual focus of the Calvary Chapel Dayton Valley Youth Ministry, only Christian music will be played at all youth events. The use of any personal listening devices will not be allowed.
- The Youth Ministry staff, the Pastor, and Elders of Calvary Chapel Dayton Valley are available to youth and their families for counseling. Referral to a licensed professional may be recommended. In accordance with the code of professional ethics, all counseling is fully confidential. Both youth and parents are guaranteed this privilege. Every attempt will be made to work with the family as a unit. By law, confidentiality cannot be upheld in the case of suicidal behavior, child abuse, situations of harm to oneself or others, or confessions of a future crime.
- The staff of Calvary Chapel Dayton Valley reserves the right to dismiss any person who will not adhere to these established policies. Participants are subject to the rules and laws of society. Individuals are liable for their own actions. Should the need arise, parent(s) will be contacted and will be expected to provide transportation home for their youth. At an off-site event, public transportation may be negotiated. Any expenses incurred will be the responsibility of the parent(s).
